Your registered writing in the attention has been observed.

In the Article 40th of the Customs Regulations titled “The information to be found in the Certificate of Origin”, information ought to be present in the certificates of origin is indicated and in the 3rd section of the aforementioned article “The country of origin of the property must be stated without allowing for any hesitation.” provision takes place.

In addition, according to the article 38/1 of the Customs Regulation, the certificate of origin submitted to customs administration to authenticate the origin of the property is required to be regulated by the competent authorities **of the country of origin or the exporter country.**

In this respect, according to the provisions of the Regulation mentioned above, the certificate of origin which is detected to not be regulated by the competent authorities of the country of origin or the exporter country and in the “Country of Origin” section of which is written “European Union” instead of the name of the related country is invalid.
